

Street Swimmers in the medals at Aqua Sulis Meet

A good sized contingent from Street and District SC participated in the competitive Aqua Sulis Level Two Meet held at Hengrove Pool in Bristol mid-November. This was the last opportunity for swimmers from across the country to set Winter National times as the qualification window closed. Chloe Edrich, who has secured several swims at Nationals, won Gold in the 200m Breast in 2:36.19 and in the 400m IM in 4:47.21, a new PB. She won Silver in the 100m Breast in 1:12.67. Beth Newton took silver in the 50m Back in 30.18, in the 50m Fly in 29.80 and also in the 100m Back in 1:05.15. She took Bronze in the 50m Free in 27.56 and the 100m Free in 58.76.

Maisie Banwell continued her run of good form taking Silver in the 100m Fly and the 50m Fly where she swam a PB of 32.46. She swam a massive PB of 5:40.86 in the 400m IM to drop 26 seconds. India Cooper won Silver in the 200m IM in 2:33.94 and placed 6th in the 100m Free in 1:01.63, very close to her PB. Isabel Waller took Bronze in the 200m Breast in 3:42.27

Jessica Edwards swam a PB of 29.66 in the 50m Free to break the 30 barrier for the first time and also swam new bests in the 100m Free in 1:05.02 and the 200m Free in 2:20.87. Joanna Black swam a PB of 33.10 in the 50m Back to place 5th. Yasmin Mahey was close to her best in the 50m Free with 30.60 as was Kyla Pike in the 50m Fly, swimming 35.62.

Harvey Pike continues to add to his medal haul, winning Gold in the 100m Breast with a PB of 1:50.33 and also in the 200m Free in 2:51.33. He took Silver in the 100m Free in 1:19.91, a 9 second improvement, and in the 50m Fly in 42.87, a two second drop.

Herbie Hallett swam an excellent 1:57.20 in the 200m Free to drop almost a second and take Gold. He took Silver in the 400m Free in 4:12.50, also a new PB. Tommy Edgar swam 32:10 in the 50m Breast to take Gold and Liam Williams took Silver in the 50m Free in 23.93, equalling his all-time best.

Oliver Willies, another national qualifier, won Gold in the 50m Fly and also in the 50m Free in a PB of 24.77. He took Silver in the 50m Back in 29.58 and in the 100m Free. Ethan Difford swam a PB of 2:58.05 in the 200m Back to place 4th and Dominic Inder -Goode was very close to his PB in 50m Free, swimming 26.68.

Charlie Hill's breaststroke times seem to drop by the week. He swam new bests in the 50m in 42.69, the 100m in 1:36.16 to place 4th and the 200m in 3:42.62, a 5 second drop. Fin Hunter-Clarke had some dramatic improvements taking 13 seconds off his 400m Free time to swim 6:10.74. He dropped 11 seconds in the 200m Breast to place 4th in 3:51.29 and 6 seconds in the 200m Back to place 5th.

A club spokesman said "There were some outstanding performances and nearly every swimmer has set significant PBs this weekend. We are especially pleased that Chloe and Ollie have got the times they need to compete at Nationals in Sheffield in December."
