Fin in top form at City Of Bristol Meet

With two meets taking place at the same time in the last weekend in October, it was a slightly smaller than usual group of Street SC swimmers that attended the City of Bristol Level 3 Course meet at Hengrove Pool. However they represented the club very well indeed.

Star of the meet was Fin Hunter-Clarke won Gold in the 100m Back in a PB of 1:36.02 and in the 200m Back in 3:27.02. He also won Gold in the 400m Free in a time of 6:27.84, which he swam for the first time and paced really well. He won Silver in the 100m Breast in 1:53.76 and the 50m Breast in 53.84. Finally he took Bronze in the 100m Free in 1:25.99. Taken together these results meant that he was the 5th highest placed boy of any age in the meet, an outstanding achievement for a 10 year old!

Alfie Hawkins won Gold in the 200m Back with a PB of 3:44.16. He also won Bronze in the 100m Back with a time of 1:44.11 and in the 200m Free in 3:47.54. Tegan Lawton won Bronze in the 400m Free in a new PB of 6:19.81 and took Silver in the 100m Breast in 1:47.14.

Bobbie Clark won Silver in the 400m IM with a PB of 6:09.94 and Bronze in the 400m Free in 5:10.52, the second time in two days that he had swum these events! Charlie Hill won Bronze in the 100m Breast with an 8 second drop to 1:40.62 and took Silver in the 50m Breast with a brilliant 45.38.

Matthew Chillingworth won Bronze in the 400m IM in 6:32.17 and swam an excellent 3:18.21 in the 200m Breast to place 4th. Luke Maunder swam 4:54.79 in the 400m Free and went 2:47.66 in the 200m IM, close to his best.

Sophie Chillingworth won Silver in the 200m Fly in 3:05.40 and swam a PB of 43.20 in the 50m Breast. Lois Engelbrecht won Silver in the 50m Back in 44.21 with an excellent finish and set a PB of 1:36.81 in the 100m Back, swimming a very hard second 50m to drop her time by 5 seconds.

Emily Trotman swam a big PB of 3:24.19 in the 200m IM and took 7 seconds off her 50m Breast time to swim 50.40. Amy Lawton swam a PB of 1:41.46 in the 100m Breaststroke and took 4 seconds off her 200m Freestyle time to record 3:01.70. Kaylee Nisbet swam a PB 1:31.73 in the 100m Back and took 12 seconds off her 200m Breast time to record a very well-paced 3:47.56

Katie Waters swam a well-paced 200m Freestyle to reduce her PB by a stunning 25 seconds to 2:46.07 and swam an excellent 1:14.15 in the 100m Free. Ellie Strudwick took 6 seconds off her PB to go 44.38 in the 50m Back and she took 15 seconds off her 200m Breast time to swim 3:26.80

A club spokesman said "This was a successful meet in particular for our younger swimmers who picked up plenty of medals and saw some big drops in their times. We are very pleased for them and it is just reward for their efforts in training"
