Street and District co-hosted their annual Autumn Open Meet with Taunton Deane, and Street swimmers grabbed an incredible 69 medals between them over an incredibly successful weekend.

Leading lights in this huge haul were Albert Tidball-Zapp who rounded off the weekend with an impressive win in the 200 backstroke and took 4 Gold and 3 Silver in his 13/o boys.

Another seven medals were bagged by Ethan Difford, winning 2 Gold, 3 Silver and 2 Bronze in the 11/o. Leading the girls Tegan Lawton bagged 4 Golds and 2 silvers, closely followed by Eve Chagger-Goode, (also 10/o) and Maisie Banwell (12/o) both triple Gold medallists.

There were notable Open meet debuts for Beverley Baker, Harriet Ford, Lucy Williams, Beth Dallimore, Martha MacPherson and Isabelle Waller. Charlie Hill also picked up 3 golds, and a Regional time for his 50 Breaststroke. Joanna Black, Jess Edwards and James White all winning a brace of Golds each. Further Golds were won by Georgia Hill, Sophie Chillingworth, Jake Fouracres and William Carr.

The younger swimmers for the Club have achieved some great swims and a raft of County qualifying times as well.
